The Need

Research shows that **79% of 4th graders** from low-income families nationwide are **not proficient** in reading.* **More than 25%** of these students **will not graduate** from high school.

The Program

In our signature Read Aloud Mentoring Program, an adult is partnered one-on-one with a student at an underserved elementary school for a weekly read-aloud experience during the child's lunch break.

The relationship typically lasts the **entire school** year and often extends multiple years through the end of the child's fourth grade.

The Impact

In recent years, nine out of ten Read to a Child students nationwide showed greater self-confidence, stronger ability to articulate their thoughts, improved listening comprehension, a bigger vocabulary, and greater enthusiasm for books and reading.
